Please be advised, **effective June 1, 2023**, there will be an increase of \$2.30 per hour, per the 2022/2024 Agreement covering Iron Workers Local No. 8's territorial jurisdiction of **Southern Wisconsin**, which includes the following counties: Kenosha, Milwaukee, Ozaukee, Racine, Washington, Waukesha, and part of Walworth.

The new rate is as follows: \$0.80 increase to Wages, \$0.50 increase to Pension, \$0.72 increase to Health & Welfare, \$0.25 to Apprentice & Skill Improvement, and \$0.03 increase to IAP/CA. **Please note the following rates include the above increase.**
