Effective June 5, 2023, the Cement Finishers total package increased \$2.00, from \$64.85 to \$66.85. The Funds have been allocated as follows: The Health and Welfare Fund increased \$0.25 per hour, from \$9.45 to \$9.70 per hour. The Pension Fund has increased \$0.45 per hour, from \$13.71 to \$14.16 per hour. The Apprenticeship Fund has remained the same. The IAP/CA Fund has remained the same. The CLMC Fund has remained the same. Our working dues have increased \$0.29 per hour, from \$2.53 to \$2.82 per hour. The Base Rate has increased from \$40.77 to \$42.07 per hour.

Effective <u>June 5, 2023 through June 2, 2024</u>, the Plasterers' total package increased \$1.97, from \$63.91 to \$65.88. The Funds have been allocated as follows: The Health and Welfare Fund increased \$0.25 per hour, from \$9.45 to \$9.70 per hour. The Pension Fund increased \$1.20 per hour, from \$14.23 to \$15.43 per hour. The Apprenticeship Fund remained the same, \$0.68 per hour, the IAP/CLMC Fund remained the same, \$0.09 per hour. Working dues increased \$0.29 per hour, from \$2.53 to \$2.82 per hour. The base rate increased \$0.52 per hour, from \$39.46 to \$39.98 per hour.

During the life of this Agreement, each Employer shall pay to the Pension Fund for each apprentice, the amount specified, for each hour worked. Commencement of such payment to the Pension Fund of the hourly contribution described in Section 1 for such newly-hired apprentices shall be deferred until such time as the apprentice has completed two (2) years of his/her apprenticeship training. The rate of contribution for a third-year apprentice shall be fifty percent (50%) of the Journeyperson contribution rate.

If the fringe benefit hourly figures are changed at any time, an amendment will be made at Appendix "A". The total package amounts will remain as stated above throughout the contract period.

Local 599 Area 558 reserves the right to divert any of the aforementioned monies to fringe benefits upon thirty (30) days notice to the ContractorS.

The pension contribution rate for a trainee shall be at the same percentage rate of the full contribution rate as his/her percentage of the full journeyman wage rate under XIX unless the trainee has previously been a participant in the Pension Fund. If the trainee has previously been a participant in the Pension Fund, the Employer shall contribute at the full contribution rate for the employee. All other working conditions and fringe benefit contributions shall be as set forth in this agreement.

To be eligible to progress to the next higher rate of pay, the individual must have completed both a minimum of six (6) months' time and 780 hours of work at his/her current rate of pay.

After the sixth (6th) six (6) month period, the trainee is a full-fledged journeyperson, and is to receive the prevailing journeyperson wage rate.

If the fringe benefit hourly figures are changed at any time, an amendment will be made at Appendix "A". The total package amounts will remain as stated above throughout the contract period.

Local 599 Area 558 reserves the right to divert any of the aforementioned monies to fringe benefits upon thirty (30) days notice to the Contractors.
